Circular No.2 -Kala Utsav 2020

Instructions for the National level Visual Art Competition

- 1. Visual Art competitions (2D, 3D and Indigenous Toys & Games) will be held on 15th and 16th January 2021 (2 days), from 10 AM to 4 PM.
- 2. For all Visual Art competitions, a single hall with dedicated space as per the social distancing guidelines for making the seating arrangements for teams (6 students) for competitions of Visual Arts (2-D, 3-D and Indigenous Toys & Games) has to be allocated for these two days. Hence, no need of any studio facility. The venue of the competitions should have proper lighting, a laptop and camera. The camera surveillance will be active on both the days of competitions from 9.30 AM to 4.30 PM, with the technical staff available throughout and the recording of the two days should be saved and sent/ mailed to the National organisers in the evening itself on 16th January, 2021. All the 6 participants will have to be given a separate table of at least 3 feet x 3 feet and a comfortable chair to work.
- 3. Teachers and mentors will have to ensure that the participants reach at their competition venues by 9.00 AM, the scheduled time and report to the in-charge / programme Co-ordinators of the State/UT/KVS/NVS..
- 4. Art materials for all the Visual Art forms will have to be arranged by the State/UT/KVS/NVS authorities. Teachers/ Mentors/ Participants will coordinate with the nodal officers regarding the requirement of materials.
- 5. The Jury will have two rounds of interactions with the participants on both the days. All the 38 venues will stay connected virtually and ensure that the students are ready for interaction with the Jury.
- 6. The nodal officers will send 5 good quality photographs of each artwork taken from different angles including one photograph of the participant with his/her artwork. The photographs should be of high resolution of at least 300DPI.
- 7. The video recording of each participant presenting his/her artwork in Visual Arts(painting(2D), sculpture(3D), Indigenous toys and games) of maximum one minute duration along with photographs have to be sent at email to <u>kalautsav.ncert@ciet.nic.in</u> on 16th January, 2021 itself.
