IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS for COMPETITIONS

(To be read carefully by all Escort Teachers and Students before competitions)

- The **programme schedule** has been provided to each team at the time of registration. The schedule of competitions provided to each team have to be strictly followed, any request to change the schedule will not be entertained.
- For all competitions, **separate venues** have been designated. Teachers and escorts will have to ensure that the teams are present at their competition venues respectively in time. Please reach "the Venues" at least an hour before the scheduled time & report to the in-charge / programme Co-ordinators.
- All participants of Dance, Instrumental and Vocal Music have to stick to the prescribed duration of 4-6 minutes for the Competitions mentioned in the Guidelines.
- An additional 5 minutes will be given for technical settings, removal of instruments, arrival and dispersal of students etc.
- **Interaction with Jury members**, accept during competition/ performance is strictly prohibited. No team members in any circumstance will discuss issues with any jury member. This will go against the norms and would amount to negative marking. The issues can be discussed with the Co-ordinator instead, if any.
- The teachers of respective teams will not be allowed to go to the stage for any announcement.
- Participants are requested to maintain etiquettes towards fellow participants and follow the rules of the competition at all times. Indiscipline of any sort will not be tolerated.
- **Accompanist** will be provided for the Music competitions (Vocal and Instrumental). Each participant will be provided with maximum of two accompanists for the performance of vocal or instrumental music. This facility will depend on the requisition placed in the Kala Utsav Entry Proforma submitted by the team. Therefore please be specific while submitting your entries for the same. **Any new requirement for the musical instrument will not be entertained.**

** Mridangam, Chenda, Sarangi and Violin also will be provided. Students who need Tanpura are requested to carry their personal electronic Tanpura. Please avoid the manual Tanpura as it is a very fragile instrument.*

- No **Musical Instruments** will be provided to the participant for performance competition in the category of Musical Instrument. Only accompaniment along with Musical Instruments is being provided. Each participant of the 'Instrumental Music' shall carry his or her own instrument for his her performance in Kala Utsav.
- Accompanists will be available for practice and tuning on 1st January, 2020 in the competition venue.
- No additional accompanist other than the participant will be allowed for **Dance competitions**.
- Participants will be provided with painting materials (sheets, canvas, crayons, paints etc.) according to the requirements which had been specified at the time of submitting the Kala Utsav entry by the team. However, students can use their own stationary (pencil, brushes, eraser etc.)
- The duration for painting competition is 2 days i.e. on 2nd - 3rd January, from 10 AM to 5 PM.
- The **size of the painting** should be 24 inches x 36 inches.
- There is no particular theme/ topic for painting competition.
